

Web site created for San Dieguito Lagoon restoration

Officials with Marathon Construction Corp. and Southern California Edison Co. announced Friday they have created a Web site to help keep people informed of progress on the San Dieguito Lagoon restoration.

The site, www.sdlagoon.com, includes site photographs, public notices, news articles, construction schedules, live Web cameras and more.

"It will be updated frequently to stay current with the quickly changing landscape of the wetlands," states a news release issued by the two companies.

Edison is paying to restore the 150-acre wetlands to compensate for damage done to marine life by the cooling system at the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station 17 miles north of Oceanside.

The restoration, which includes opening the lagoon to permanent tidal flushing, is expected to take three years and cost more than \$80 million.
