San Dieguito Lagoon project is meeting topic

DEL MAR -- The San Dieguito Lagoon restoration project will be the topic for a free informational meeting at 6 p.m. Wednesday at the Powerhouse Community Center, 1658 Coast Blvd., Del Mar.

Among those scheduled to answer questions is Mike Furby, president of Marathon Construction Corp., the contractor for the \$86 million project, which has reached its halfway point. Hany Elwany, a coastal engineer assigned to the project, is also on the program along with biologists, archaeologists, paleontologists and others involved with the effort.

The three-year restoration project encompasses 440 acres to the east and west of Interstate 5, reaching all the way to the ocean. It is designed to create a thriving habitat for birds and fish.
